

# The Chinese University of Hong Kong Shaw College Exchange Programmes 2025/26 Application Guidelines

# **Special Note**

- 1. The finalized list of exchange programmes and associated places might not be available until early-January 2024 so the current list of exchange programmes and respective admission requirements are for reference only.
- 2. When applying, you should list your preferred exchange destination(s) in the <u>Online Application Form (Part I)</u>. You have to review the finalized exchange programme list and revise your choices around early-January 2024.
- 3. Each student could only accept one offer for 2025/26, regardless of exchange period. Therefore, students who had accepted a term-time exchange offer for 2025/26 from any CUHK units will not be given any offer by Shaw College.
- 4. Applications from eligible students who have neither been on term-time nor summer exchange will be placed before those who had been on term-time and/or summer exchange.

## <u>Eligibility</u>

- 1. Due to limited places available, the following rules will be implemented for the 2025/26 outgoing exchange selection exercise (this selection).
  - 1.1 All full-time undergraduate students of Shaw College are eligible in this selection.
  - 1.2 Higher priority will be given to students Year 2 or above and Year 1 (senior-year intake ONLY).
  - 1.3 According to the <u>Regulations Governing Full-time Undergraduate Studies</u>, CUHK students who have satisfied all graduation requirements shall graduate (Regulation 12.1). Students are strongly recommended to plan in advance for their academic studies so as to go on exchange <u>before</u> earning all credit units required for CUHK graduation (i.e. avoid extension of study period for exchange after fulfilling all graduation requirements).
- 2. Specific requirements of admission vary according to the exchange programme. Here are some of the typical requirements:
  - 2.1 In good academic and disciplinary standing at CUHK (cumulative GPA of 2.70 or above and fulfill the GPA requirement set by the host institution)
  - 2.2 Possess a valid TOEFL or IELTS score report issued on or after 1 September 2023 (the minimum score required will vary between different programmes)
  - 2.3 Commit to submitting a 1,000-word reflection report in English and 3 to 5 photos related to their exchange experience within 1 month upon completion of the programme
  - 2.4 Have basic knowledge of the country or region where you intend to study
  - 2.5 Demonstrate maturity and responsibility in social conduct
  - 2.6 Embrace and respect cultural diversities and differences
  - 2.7 Be physically and emotionally healthy
  - 2.8 Ready to be an exchange student representing Shaw College and CUHK

#### <u>Deposit</u>

- 1. Applicants who accept an exchange nomination offer will be requested to settle the payment of a refundable deposit in the amount of HK\$1,500. Failure to settle the deposit payment on or before the deadline for accepting offer will imply forfeiture of the offer.
- 2. The deposit will not be refunded if (i) students request to withdraw from the programme after their acceptance of the exchange nomination offer; or (ii) fail to submit the reflection report with photos to Shaw College by the specified deadline.
- 3. The deposit will be refunded after you have submitted the reflection report with photos to the College upon completion of the exchange programme.
