Opening ceremony & orientation, campus tour, Kyoto University introduction, academic lectures, Japanese language classes, fieldtrip, cultural experience, discussion session in English, conversation with Kyoto University students in Japanese, lab visit, final presentation, completion ceremony, farewell party and student planned activity.
