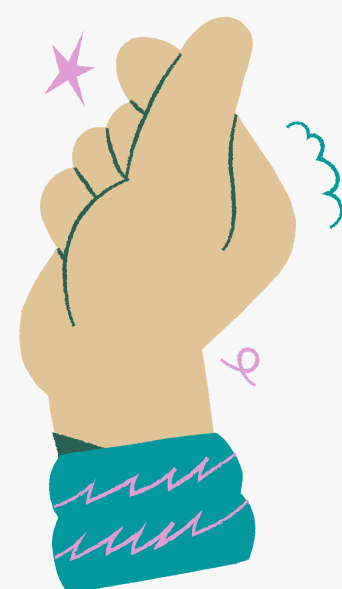




Basic Korean & Korean Culture Workshop for Beginners

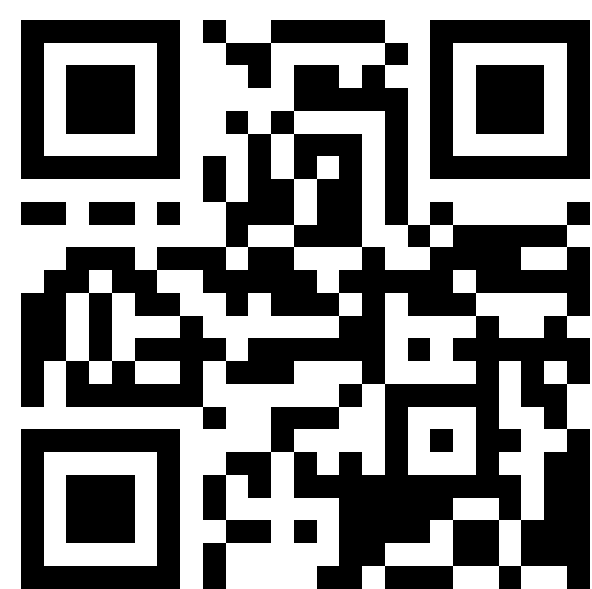
