Session 1:  Giving a structured, clear and concise presentation: organization of a presentation, proper transitions between sections, conciseness when presenting ideas  Session 2:  Learning from good speakers: analysis of presentations and speeches from students, award-winning presenters and famous people  Session 3:  Mastering verbal and non-verbal delivery skills: verbal delivery skills (fluency, voice projection and pronunciation), non-verbal delivery skills (hand gesture, posture, eye contact and facial expression), use of visual aids, specific delivery skills for presentations on Zoom  Session 4:  Tackling impromptu speeches: ways of structuring our thoughts quickly, preparation for impromptu speeches in daily life	It provides an intensive preparation for the IELTS (Academic) test covering listening, academic reading, academic writing and speaking modules. This workshop focuses on identifying strategies and enhancing English language skills for academic purposes to gain maximum advantage in the IELTS (Academic) test.
