

Shaw College Student Exemplary Awards

Objective:

The awards are to recognize students for their academic success, exemplary personal attributes that contribute to a role model, and their tremendous efforts and readiness to serve the College, University, as well as the community. The awardees are expected to make an impact on their peers, serve as role models to promote a supportive learning environment in the College with a view to an advancement of both students' academic success and whole person excellence.

Number of awards:

8 awards, 1 award for each faculty (Arts, Business Administration, Education, Engineering, Law, Medicine, Science and Social Science.)

Value of each award:

HK\$10,000

Eligibility:

All full time non-first year undergraduate students of any disciplines who:

- 1. have exemplary personal qualities, i.e. integrity, achievements echoing College's Founding Aspiration, etc.; AND
- 2. have obtained good academic performance, with a minimum GPA of 3.25; AND
- 3. have demonstrated strong dedication to serving the College, University as well as the community.

Students can only receive the awards once during their course of study.

Selection:

All non-first year students of Shaw College are welcome to apply for the awards. Shortlisted candidates shall be invited to attend an in-person interview. <u>Applicants should be nominated by at least 1 teacher.</u>

Commitment of the Awardees:

Awardees shall be given priority to join various college's programmes and they shall be ready to support in the programmes, e.g. orientation programmes, student development programmes, summer / winter programmes, high table dinner, cultural integration programme, etc.

Nomination:

- 1. Nomination should be made by at least one teacher (nomination form can be downloaded from https://www.shaw.cuhk.edu.hk/sites/default/files/share/files/downloads/nomination_form.pdf
- 2. To avoid conflict of interest, Chairman and members of Scholarship, Award and Financial Assistance Committee are not eligible for serving as nominators.

Application:

- 1. Applicants are required to complete and submit the online application form https://cloud.itsc.cuhk.edu.hk/webform/view.php?id=13672048.
- 2. Print out the application form in PDF format received via CUHK email address, together with the following required supporting documents, submit to Information Counter at LG1, Wen Lan Tang, Shaw College on or before the deadline.
 - 2.1 ONE-page Personal Statement, share with the selection panel on how you have had exemplary personal qualities with your key achievements echoing the Founding Aspiration of Shaw College, "Learning, innovation, and benefitting humankind";
 - 2.2 Proofs of Awards / Scholarships / Prizes received in the past 3 years;
 - 2.3 Proofs of Extra-curricular Activities / Community Service / other achievement that you participated in the past 3 years;
 - 2.4 Unofficial transcript as at Term 2, 2022/23.
- 3. Nomination forms can be submitted separately by the nominators.
- 4. Extended deadline for online application is 16 October 2023 (Monday).
- 5. Extended deadline for submitting supporting documents and nomination forms is <u>4:00pm, 20</u> October 2023 (Friday).

Late and/or incomplete application will not be considered.
